

Concept

IDKD – International Diagnostic Course Davos – offers interactive teaching workshops presented by a highly qualified International Faculty. The annually changing courses are organ-based with the topics: Brain, Head & Neck and Spine – Heart and Chest – Abdomen & Pelvis – Musculoskeletal. IDKD is offering courses in Davos, Switzerland, in Greece and in Asia.
